### Bell Creek Park's Parking Lot Yard Waste, Bulky Items, Large Household Items & Recycling

Please line up at the Park's entrance on Bell Canyon Road. Traffic Management, LLC will be providing traffic control. As you know there is a one lane driveway and limited space, so vehicles will be admitted a few at a time and then must exit before more cars/trucks will be admitted. County workers will be onsite to assist in unloading.

Bricks, concrete chunks, etc., must be placed into buckets or containers. No one can shovel loose materials out of a truck bed or trailer. Buckets and containers will be returned upon proper disposal.

### **Bulky Item Pickup At Your Home Is Available On Trash Days (Tuesdays)**

Waste Management/GI Industries offers curbside pickup on Bell Canyon's **regular trash day (Tuesdays)**. Items include couches, mattresses, toilets, and water heaters. A two (2) item pickup (minimum) costs \$58.99, and each item after is \$20.44. In order to take advantage of this service, you must CALL and schedule a pickup. Items left on your curb will not be picked up without prior notification.
