Drop off trash, residential construction debris and bulky items at the gravel lot next to the Playground.

Yard Waste at the gravel lot next to the Playground

Trash, large items and Residential Construction Only. Debris (No Contractor Dumping) at the gravel lot next to the Playground



Please bag leaves and grass. *Large tree limbs do not need to be bagged as they will be chipped.* Palm trees and palm fronds must be kept separate from other branches as they cannot be chipped.

Place bricks, concrete chunks etc., into buckets or containers – the crew cannot shovel loose materials out of truck beds or trailers. Your reusable containers will be returned to you after they are emptied!

Please line up at the Park entrance on Bell Canyon Road. CERT will provide traffic control. There is a one lane driveway and limited space so vehicles will be admitted a few at a time to empty trash/yard waste and then exit. WM workers will be onsite to assist in unloading.

ACCEPTABLE BULK ITEMS INCLUDE

- Furniture such as couches, tables, chairs, beds, mattresses, and metal furniture
- Basketball goal - Remove concrete base & cut to 6 ft. or less
- Bed frames - Dismantle.
- Bikes
- Box springs.
- Couches
- Chairs
- Desks - Empty.
- Dressers - Empty.
- Grills - Remove propane tanks; 60 lbs. or less; no commercial grills.
- Gutters - 4 ft. or less.
- Linoleum - Roll & cut no longer than 4 ft.; no more than 60 lbs.
- Patio Furniture
- Pool Covers - Folded; only folded covers 60 lbs or less will be collected.
- Push Lawnmowers - Remove gasoline; remove battery, if applicable.
- Toilets - Clean & empty.
- Toys
- Bricks
- Cinderblocks
- Concrete
- Household Trash
- Plaster
- Rocks
- Roofing material
- Sheetrock
- Shingles
- Yard waste
- Branches & Brush - Cut to 4-6 ft. or less; no railroad ties. No treated wood
- Building/Construction Materials
- Cardboard boxes. Please cut down to 3 feet by 3 feet (or smaller) pieces and place in the recycling cart for collection
- Ceramic tile

- Duct or sheet metal

ITEMS NOT ACCEPTABLE FOR COLLECTION INCLUDE

Electronic Waste

Televisions, computers and related computer equipment, CPUs, laptops, monitors, printers, printer/fax/scan devices, mice, and keyboards.

- **Any materials resulting from work performed by a commercial contractor.**
 - **Automobile parts, including motors, tires on rims, doors, fenders, car seats, batteries, and bumpers**
- Central air conditioning or heating units
- Chain link fencing
- Fence posts with concrete attached
- Fire-damaged items
- Grocery carts
- Oil Drums
- Paint & other hazardous waste
- Propane/oxygen tanks
- Railroad ties
- Soil
- Sand
- Tires
- White Goods/large appliances (washers, dryers, refrigerators, stoves/ovens, dishwashers, freezers, dehumidifiers, microwaves)
